It also seems to bestow sense of peace. [but] there is danger to be misunderstood it as Sera that you are looking for. At that time you are totally deluded and wrong.

They are neither disciples of Tsongkhapa who provide the rays of wisdom, nor direct disciples of the Dalai Lama who promote peace. They are the group who worship a spirit as a deity. And they are the small group of army who secretly appreciate the kindness of the Uncle [referring to China].

When Kyabje Pabonkha appeared in this world, some didn't understand him at all. So he had to abandon them when he passed away. Later Kyabje Trijang Rinpoche had to leave them without understanding these people. Indeed they are teachers and fathers of these people. In view of their continued disgrace of Kyabje Pabongkhapa, the race of these people is really malevolent

## Every time I cross Camp No 3, I spit [force out saliva] toward them.

People curse that there is impure barbed wire in pure land of Lhasa. The curse doesn't apply to those who follow Buddha. If I see them being rotten by cursing, I will never regret and repent.
